Shuttering of Local Newspapers

“What happens to archives of community newspapers shut down in the Torstar-Postmedia deal?”

Reporter Kate Dubinski (Dec 6, 2017) questioned who tells communities stories when local newspapers close.



Stewardship and access of community newspapers

“A *Torstar* spokesperson said the company hasn't figured out what to do with physical archives yet, but that in the long-term, the company wants to make the archives available to the public. “

“A *Postmedia* spokesperson said the company is open to inquiries from universities, libraries and museums that might be interested in preserving those archives.”



Advocating for our community heritage

- Letter to Postmedia and Torstar (OLA December 15th, AAO December 21st), cc'ed to CBC
- Coordinating a “working group”: AAO, AO, LAC, ODW, OLA and TPL
- Survey to archives and libraries
- Meetings with Postmedia and TorStar representatives
- Framework for Collaboration

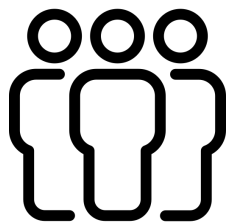


GLAMs Concerns about the Shuttering of Local Newspapers

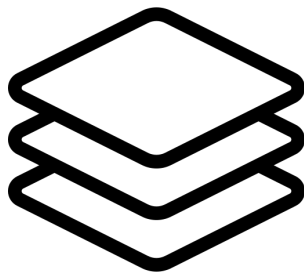
- What happens to the archives & back-files of the newspapers?

38 participants



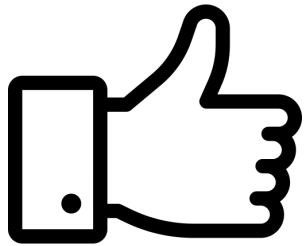
13 institutions have

62% stewarding newspaper archives



75% agreed to provide accessibility to newspaper archives



65% provide storage of shuttered newspapers



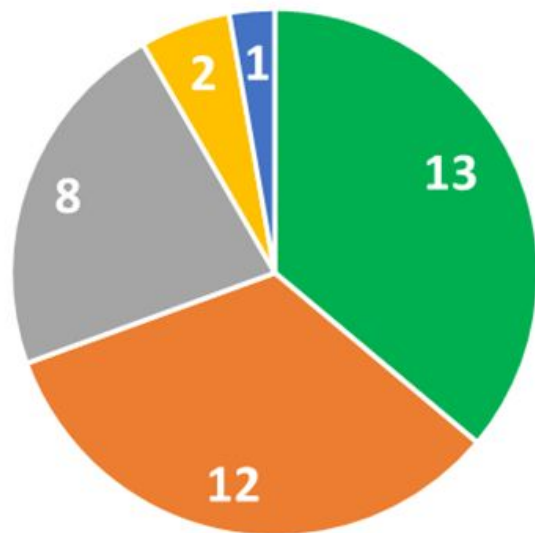

■ Newspapers not found anywhere

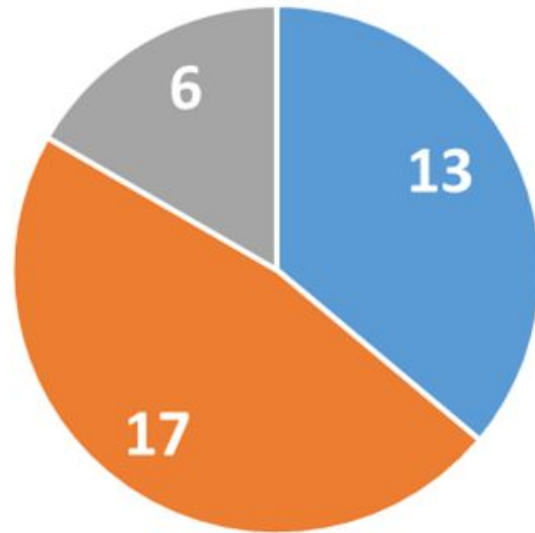
■ Newspapers held in 1 location

■ Newspapers held in 3 locations

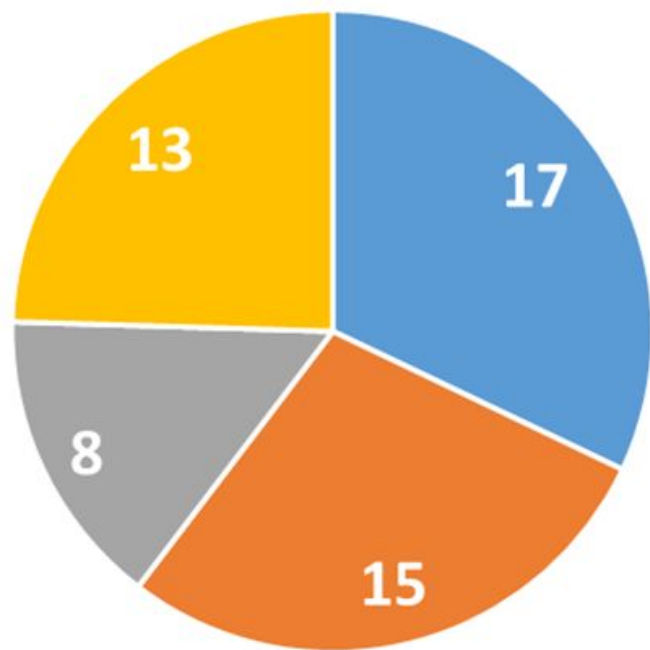
■ Newspapers held in 4 or more locations

For news publishers

- Has been drafted - for discussion at next Steering Committee meeting in June



Newspapers, eh? LAC's Newspaper Strategy

Environmental scan underpinning the Strategy found:

- Client demand is high
- NHDS internal survey - newspapers most highly prioritized material
- LAC has growing gaps in collection
- TorStar/PostMedia shuttered papers highlight the issue of risk of loss



Newspaper Strategy - Plans

Establish a collaborative collection - solicit ideas, commitment to participate and a national view of collections

Newspaper Summit, Collaboration Framework

National Inventory - see europeana.eu



Framework Document for Collaboration

- Access and preservation of closed newspapers
 - Published copies - no gaps in historical record
 - Archives (photos and reporter files)
- Standard agreements and templates for digitization and access (and transfer of custody)
- Workflow and protocols for newspapers that are currently being shuttered, and those that will be in the future
- Collective, long-term solution for online access to digitized newspapers
